

Twenty years after building our Eruv we completed our second expansion; moving west and north. We have begun work on the dish mikvah, donated by Jay and Cheryl Lamport in memory of her parents, Clarence and Lillian Zitaner - long time pillars of our community. The front stairs were repaired and coated, making them more aesthetically pleasing and safer to walk on.

The Community Growth Committee put in a lot of work to lay the foundation for growth campaigns. The next steps, after the chagim, are to implement campaigns that put Malden on people's radar when they are looking for a Jewish community in Boston.

How You Can Help

Kiddush

Individual sponsorships

Kiddush is the hub of social life in our community. We gather every week after Shabbat morning services and shmooze over delicious refreshments. Your sponsorship will be included in the weekly bulletin and announced in the Shabbat announcements for the week of your choosing.

Luncheon** - \$360 Helps cover the cost of one Shabbat Chazak or Shabbat Nachamu luncheons Basic Kiddush - \$100 Includes a regular kiddush plus kugel Gala Kiddush - \$120 Includes a Basic Kiddush plus fancy cakes Lavish Kiddush - \$150 Includes a Gala Kiddush plus additional salads (e.g., egg salad, cole slaw) or fancy herring

** Note - This luncheon sponsorship is only for regularly scheduled luncheons. For a simcha luncheon, the host is not charged a rental fee, but is required to cover the entire cost of the luncheon. Non-scheduled luncheons must be approved by the Rabbi and Executive Director.
